
Frequently Asked Questions: Gunjan 2017

WHAT LAB SHOULD I CHOOSE? HOW TO DECIDE WHICH LAB TO OPT FOR?

In making the lab selection, we suggest you look at the first thing that seems to attract you. It is usually about what is alive in our sub-conscious/unconscious. Ask yourself a couple of questions such as – what is happening in your life at the moment? OR what is it that you wish to discover about yourself? You can speak with participant co-ordinators for further discussion.

CAN I DO MORE THAN ONE LAB AT TIME? CAN I DO SELECTED SESSIONS IN DIFFERENT LABS ACROSS THE 3 DAYS?

No. You need to select one lab that you would like to participate in. The labs are designed to do in-depth work on the theme across 3 days. However, there may be open sessions that are offered by facilitators, which you may attend depending on your interest and convenience.

WHAT SUPPORT DO I GET POST LAB? CAN I CONTACT THE FACILITATOR POST LAB, IF I NEED HELP?

ISABS believes in supporting as a community and the professional members are available for help, if any. We hold monthly meetings in the chapter to stay connected and continue learning. Further, we encourage you to create your support system amongst participants.

In case of specific help needed from lab facilitator, we suggest that you may want to negotiate time with the concerned person, directly.

IS THIS LAB COUNTED AS MILESTONE IN ISABS, INSTEAD OF BLHP/ALHP?

No. These are theme labs and not counted as a substitute of BLHP/ALHP

IS THIS LAB COUNTED AS MILESTONE IN MY PDP JOURNEY, IF IT CATERES TO SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATIONS RECEIVED BY ME TO WORK ON? CAN I GET CLEARED FOR NEXT LEVEL IN MY PDP JOURNEY IN SUCH A LAB, BY GETTING FACILITATOR EVALUATION FOR FOCUSED WORK DONE ON THEME THAT I WAS ASKED TO WORK ON? CAN I USE THIS LAB TO GET CLEARED FOR NEXT LEVEL OF PDP, EVEN IF I MAY NOT BE WORKING ON A SPECIFIC THEME, INSTEAD OF DOING AN ALHP/1 WEEK IN PHASE A OR B/INTERN'S LAB?

First and foremost, theme labs are essentially designed for self-work and do not follow the pure T-group lab format. So it will not be considered a substitute for ALHP/1 week in phase A or B/Intern's lab etc. You will have to do an ALHP or whatever is specifically recommended for you.

Theme labs are really an investment into one's own learning. However, we recognize that it is an opportunity to work on specific issues that most PDP members grapple with in their PDP journey. Therefore, it may help forward their journey in some ways. Should they wish to use a specific theme lab to get cleared for next level in their PDP journey, the suggested process is as follows;

PDP members need to consult the facilitator of the chosen lab as well as Dean-PDP, to develop an understanding of whether the lab will address their specific learning needs. If, it is agreed upon by all concerned that it will indeed address the learning need, the PDP member needs to independently negotiate with the facilitator of the lab, to use the lab for his/her learning and getting clearance to next level in the PDP journey. The facilitator will have to give a written feedback to the PDP member clearly stating observations and recommendations based on work done in the lab. Please note that the decision is subject to various factors, such as whether the lab is designed to accommodate such learning needs, whether the time frame allows the PDP member to work in depth on his/her learning need and experience visible shifts etc.

CAN I PAY EXTRA AND TAKE SINGLE OCCUPANCY ROOMS?

We believe that a lot of learning happens through shared experiences. Therefore, ISABS does not offer single occupancy option. We encourage you to share double or triple occupancy as offered.

CAN WE GET TO SHARE ROOMS WITH PEOPLE WE KNOW?

In interest of creating an opportunity for a wider experiential learning, as well as providing space for experimenting and exploring, we recommend that all work be done with members not known to you. Lab groups and rooming is created keeping this in mind. We encourage you to push your boundaries and explore newer possibilities.

CAN I BRING MY FAMILY WITH ME IF I PAY FOR THEIR ACCOMMODATION ETC.?

We do not have provision for the family to stay on premises. The venue is booked for the participants only.

HOW LONG IT WILL TAKE TO TRAVEL TO THE VENUE FROM THE AIRPORT / BY ROAD FROM VARIOUS LOCATIONS?
