ABOUT ISABS

ABOUT HUMAN PROCESS LABS:

In a Human Process Laboratory, a group of around 10-12 participants work together along with a facilitator to learn about human processes, and in the process discover more about themselves, their strengths, their styles, their interpersonal and group interactions, how they perceive others, and are perceived by others. While this is the primary task, there is no predetermined agenda and the group uses the 'here and now' experience to derive this learning, using each other as a resource. The facilitators help create a climate for such learning.

About BLHP- Basic Lab on Human Process

This lab is the beginning of a journey that takes the participant deeper into his/her self-awareness. The Basic Lab is meant for any person interested in developing his/her personal and interpersonal competence and becoming more effective.

The lab objectives are to help participants;

- ☞ Enhance one's effectiveness in interpersonal and group interactions and derive greater satisfaction from them
- ☞ Become aware of one's patterns of behaviour and its impact on others
- ☞ Recognize feelings and become more sensitive to one's own as well as others' needs
- ☞ Improve one's ability to deal with conflict functionally and
- ☞ Discover one's potential to live life meaningfully and effectively

- ☞ Line Managers and Executives
- ☞ Marketing, Sales and Client Servicing professionals
- ☞ Team or Group Leaders and Project Coordinators
- ☞ TQM & ISO supervisors
- ☞ HRD, Training, Personnel and Industrial Relations Professionals
- ☞ Counsellors and Therapists
- ☞ School and University Faculty
- ☞ Professionals from NGOs, voluntary and social service organizations

About ALHP- Advanced Lab on Human Process

This lab is conceptualized to help further the journey of self-awareness that has begun with a BLHP. All those Individuals who have participated in a Basic Lab on Human Processes or its equivalent (L-Group/Human Relations Programs in laboratory mode etc.) and have been cleared for attending Advanced Lab, can participate in an ALHP. ALHP is essential for those expecting/desirous of pursuing the Professional Development Program (PDP) of ISABS.

The lab objectives are to help participants;

- ☞ Enhance learning and experimentation initiated by oneself in the Basic Lab and thereafter
- ☞ Practice skills of better listening, being more authentic and empathetic
- ☞ Develop greater awareness of behavioural processes of individuals, as experienced in the here & now
- ☞ Become familiar with group dynamics and how these impact behaviour of individuals

ALHP is particularly recommended for

- ☞ Executives, Administrators and Managers
- ☞ Internal HRD facilitators and personnel engaged in change management
- ☞ ISO Management Representatives and TQM Facilitators
- ☞ NGO and Government staff in people-management roles

The Regional Coordinator will revert to you on the amount of bursary we can offer based on the total number of applications received and relative merits of the case.
