Resurgence 2021 is a global event open to participants from across the world. Participants may enroll for a Lab in a format and time slot that suits them the best.

ABOUT HUMAN PROCESS LABORATORY (LAB)

Typically in a Human Process Laboratory, a group of around 10-12 participants work together along with facilitator/s to learn about more about human behaviour and the various interlinked aspects. In the "lab" they learn through experience, reflection and actively experimenting with new behaviours in a contained manner / safe space. The participants discover more about themselves, their strengths, their styles, their interpersonal and group interactions, how they perceive others, and are perceived by others. The group uses the 'here and now' experience to derive this learning, utilising each other as a resource. The facilitator/s support in creating a climate for such learning.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARTICIPANTS:

- 1. Human Process Labs bring with them a certain depth and churning. They can be a thrilling as well as demanding learning journey, which continues beyond the labs. It is important that you recognize the unusual circumstances that we are in and seek support, if needed once the lab closes for the day.
- 2. ISABS will extend the best possible support to all participants, within the restrictions placed upon us by the current pandemic.
- 3. In sending us your nomination, you are confirming to ISABS that you have read and understood the details and that you agree to take responsibility for the unique outcomes of the program, when you nominate yourself for the lab.
- 4. Your nomination will be accepted subject to logistics and technical requirements being fulfilled. *Ref* Annexure 2 for details.

ISABS programmes focus on building competency in personal effectiveness and making it available for organizational and societal growth and development. Participants in ISABS labs are likely to become more sensitive to their and others' feelings, needs and behaviors as well as understand their own and others' behaviour more clearly.

ABOUT ECHO I:

THIS LAB WILL FOCUS ON "SELF" AND CREATE CONDITIONS FOR INTRA PERSONAL EXPLORATION.

This lab is the beginning of a journey that takes the participant deeper into his/her self-awareness. ECHO I is meant for persons interested in developing his/her personal and interpersonal competence and becoming more effective.

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Become aware of her/his/their patterns of behaviour and their impact on others;
- 2. Improve her/his/ their effectiveness in interpersonal interactions.
- 3. Recognize feelings, diagnose needs and improve her/his/their ability to deal with differences.
- 4. Learn the basics of group processes and their impact on self and others

ABOUT ECHO II:

This lab will be anchored more on "Self in group" rather than a simple self-exploration of ECHO Step I.

This lab is conceptualized to help further the journey of self-awareness that has begun with ECHO I or a BLHP in an ISABS event. Those Individuals who have participated in ECHO I or Basic Lab on Human Processes and have been cleared for attending ECHO II or an Advanced Lab, may participate in ECHO II.

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Understand group processes and how group processes impact self and vice versa
- 2. Develop greater awareness of self, interpersonal and group processes and explore with that awareness.
- 3. Develop understanding around issues of diversity, especially gender, age, religion and caste.
- 4. Practice and learn the skills of making process observations.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (PDP)

1st edition of the Professional Development Programme (PDP) in an online format using virtual medium has been executed in years 2020 and 2021. We are beginning the 2nd edition of the same in Aug 2021. The program is held in a slightly different design. The two weeks of both Phase A and Phase B are offered separated by a gap of time. A reflection session is scheduled between the two weeks.

This methodology, popularly known as 'T-Group', 'L-Group', 'Sensitivity Training' or 'Laboratory Education' is primarily through experience, and can be more specifically defined as "learning through reflection on doing". With personal growth comes the ability to understand the group, and the organization. It helps in developing the ability to interact in a more authentic, open and spontaneous fashion, the ability to recognize one's feelings, accept the vulnerability of sharing them and take the risk of becoming fully engaged with another person and/or a group of people.
