Being helpful is inherent to all of us. It is fundamental human nature. But we are not necessarily always helpful in the ways we offer help. Sometimes we end up harming more than helping consciously or unconsciously. The central theme of this session is learning to be an effective "Helper" as best as we can. This becomes more relevant especially in times of Covid where helplessness is taking root in our hearts. It's time to remember that all of us can help, if not everyone, at least someone!

Broad learning objectives of the session:

- Learning how to offer, receive and give help in an effective manner.
- Discovering why my help is not helpful sometimes.
- Discovering what blocks, me from receiving or asking for help.

Methodology: Experiential learning. Participants will largely engage in conversations about helping and learn from each other. Some theoretical inputs will be included to build a greater understanding of the concept of "Help".
